SAFS/SRC OBJECTIVE

The SAFS/SRC is an entry-level program designed as an introduction to the sport of High Power Rifle Competition for new participants. It is also for persons with an interest in improving their shooting skills and who are currently involved in High Power Rifle competitions. Recreational shooters and shooters from other disciplines will also benefit from this course. As a result of this training, the novice shooter should be able to enter and safely participate in High Power Rifle Competition.

SAFS/SRC DESCRIPTION

The SAFS/SRC is conducted by a team of highly qualified retired U.S. Armed Forces, civilian CMP and NRA nationally ranked and Distinguished Riflemen, and High Power Rifle Instructor/Shooters augmented by volunteer rifle competitors from local clubs. The training emphasizes Range & Firearms Safety, Service Rifle Marksmanship Fundamentals and Techniques, Match Operations and Procedures, Zeroing, and Operation of the *U.S. Service Rifle AR-15 (M16)*. The training includes classroom instruction and closely supervised Dry Fire and Live Fire Instruction Practice under individual trainer/coaches. **NOTE THAT ONLY THE AR15 in A2 configuration WILL BE USED FOR THESE CLASSES!**

RAIN/ALTERNATE DATES

In the event of a weather cancellation of firing and as an option, participants may elect to fire on any of the monthly Forbes High Power League Match dates in lieu of firing on Sunday if you attended the Forbes SAFS. All 2010 league dates can be found on the web at <http://www.nyhighpower.com>.

ELIGIBILITY

This event is open to the public. **All participants must be NYSRPA or NRA members.** High Power Rifle competition is a sport requiring stamina and physical flexibility. **All participants should be in good health and in reasonably good physical condition and be able to assume the prone and sitting firing positions for sustained periods.** Youths must be at least 14 years old. All applicants **must** have some previous experience and familiarity with firearms. **This course is NOT for persons who have never handled firearms.**

REGISTRATION FEES

Adult Civilians, two days: \$60, Saturday only: \$35.
U.S. Armed Forces, two days: \$50, Sat. only: \$30.
Youths 14 thru 19, two days: \$30, Sat. only: \$15.
Late registration (walk-ons) Sat. ONLY, Adults: \$35, Armed Forces: \$30, Youths: \$15.

ENTRIES ARE LIMITED

Seminar Phase (Saturday) 70, Range Phase (Sunday) 60 (four relays). The first 60 paid entries will be squadded for Sunday firing.

REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

- Mail in registration is required for all students, escorting adults and sponsors (see registration form enclosed)
- Complete form and mail with check or money order.
- Registration must be accompanied by full fees and entry form.
- Registration for the Forbes SAFS must be received by April 6, 2010
- Cancellations received prior to the above deadlines will receive a full refund. A \$10 cancellation fee will apply thereafter.
- Entries will not be accepted for the range phase only.
- Registrations will be confirmed if received by the above deadlines and accompanied by a self addressed stamped envelope or E-mail address.

THERE WILL BE NO REFUNDS FOR NO SHOWS.

CONDITIONS:

- Participants are required to comply with all safety rules and instructions.
- Students are required to attend and participate in the complete seminar training on Saturday in order to shoot on Sunday.
- All youths under age 18 must be accompanied by an adult sponsor or youth group leader. One (1) adult may sponsor and accompany a group.
- Youths under 16 years old must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian or submit written parental permission and be accompanied by a responsible adult as required by NYS Penal Law, section 265.20.
- All students are required to act as scorers and target operators.

RIFLES USED FOR THE SAFS AND FOR LOAN

- This training is limited to the U.S. Service Rifles, M16 (AR-15) in the A2 configuration or commercial equivalents, with standard sights. A limited number of AR-15s will be available for loan with priority given to juniors and ladies.
- Students borrowing rifles are required to purchase caliber .223 ammunition which will be sold for fair market value (minimum of \$25 for 50 rounds). No other ammunition will be fired from borrowed rifles. **These prices are subject to change.** Students are encouraged to bring their own service rifles both days.
- **Personal firearms must not be brought into the classroom.** Personal rifles should be brought to the afternoon dry fire training. Rifles with “muzzle brakes” are not allowed.

AMMUNITION

- Live ammunition must not be brought to the Saturday seminar. Armor piercing, incendiary and tracer ammunition is not allowed. Fifty (50) rounds of ammunition are required per shooter.
- While we should have sufficient commercial ammunition in caliber .223 for sale for personal rifles, please try and secure the appropriate ammunition to bring with you. We regret that we can no longer offer ammunition at a discount to Juniors or Military.

CERTIFICATES OF TRAINING

- A “certificate of training” will be issued to each student that completes both phases of training. The “certificate of training,” issued by a CMP authorized SAFS or clinic, fulfills one of the requirements for purchase a U.S. Army surplus service grade M1s from the CMP.

EQUIPMENT & CLOTHING

- Hearing and eye protection are mandatory for the firing phase. A limited number of shooting coats, mitts, gloves and mats are available for loan to students. Students are encouraged to bring their own shooting equipment and clothing to include; rifleman jackets, spotting scopes or field glasses. Students should wear appropriate outdoor clothing both days to include; warm clothing, sweaters, sweat shirts, denim or heavy cloth trousers, boots, hats and rain gear. Students should bring a notebook and pen.

- **NO FOOD SERVICE WILL BE AVAILABLE AT THE SAFS!** Students must bring their own breakfast, lunch, snacks, beverages, etc. each day.

LODGING

- There are numerous motels close by to the Forbes Club range. Most are located on Central Avenue or Wolf Road in the Albany airport area. Check the www.nyhighpower.com website for and possible special deals should we be able to arrange them.

DIRECTIONS

Rifle Range Road is located off of Route 155 (New Karner Road), between Route 5 (Central Ave) and Route 20 (Western Ave). Drive through Watervliet Fish & Game Club and you will enter the range behind the 300 yard line. (Note: on Thursday's, during 600 yard practice, the gate will be open and you should enter at the 600 yard line)

From 90 West & 87 South: Take Exit 24 to the Northway. Take Exit 2W and proceed on Central Ave (5 West) until 155 South. Make a left hand turn onto 155. Rifle Range Road will be on the right.

From 90 East: Take the Fuller Road exit. At the end of the ramp make the left at the traffic light. Make the first right at Washington Ave Extension. At the end, make a right onto 155. Rifle Range Road will be on the left.
